2. ***Eat with Your Family Day***

“Eat with Your Family Day” (EWYFD) is a nation-wide initiative led by the *Centre for Fathering* and supported by the *Ministry of Social and Family Development (MSF)*, to encourage all Singaporeans to consciously set aside time that day to be with their families. Through the simple act of having a family meal, we hope the event will serve as a reminder to families to eat together regularly. Since 2022, MOE has supported all four EWYFD on the last Friday of each school term. The stipulated dates for 2026 are indicated below:

- 13 March 2026
- 29 May 2026
- 4 September 2026
- 20 November 2026

3. ***Travel Declaration***
