7. Primary 5 National Education (NE) Show

As part of the key National Education efforts, NE Shows have been organised since 1997 to provide a cohort experience for Primary 5 students to immerse in the full 'live' spectacle of the National Day Parade (NDP). This year, our students will have the opportunity to watch the parade at the Padang on **Saturday, 8 July**.

8. Racial Harmony Day (EHD) Commemoration

The theme for Racial Harmony Day (RHD) this year is **Singapore: Our Multicultural Mosaic**. It reflects how communities in Singapore are unique yet intertwined to create the cultural diversity that characterises Singapore life. In KCS, we will be focusing on the sub-theme, **You and I (Unity in Diversity)**.

The school will commemorate RHD from **17 to 21 July** by having a variety of activities to deepen our students' understanding of racial harmony in Singapore. On **19 and 21 July**, we will have Traditional Games Days@Kampung Kheng Cheng to expose students to traditional games and handicrafts.
