3. 2023 Primary One Registration Exercise - Phase 1 Registration

The Phase 1 registration is for a Singapore Citizen (SC) or Permanent Resident (PR) child born between 2 January 2017 and 1 January 2018 (both dates inclusive) and has a sibling currently studying in our school. For the 2023 Primary 1 Registration Exercise (2023 P1 Ex), parents who are registering their younger child under Phase 1 are to register during the Phase 1 registration period in early July 2023. Parents are not required to submit Phase 1 registration from April 2023. If your child is a non-SC / non-PR and thus not eligible for Phase 1, please submit an online indication of interest in end May or early June 2023. More updates on the Primary 1 Registration Exercise (2023 P1 Ex) will be provided on the MOE P1 website by May 2023.

4. Learning Festival

The Learning Festival is a new event in Kheng Cheng School. It will be held on the last week of Term 2 where we want to celebrate our learning for the semester. It is a culmination of activities from the Applied Learning Program (ALP), Learning for Life Program (LLP), Education and Career Guidance (ECG), English and Mother Tongue Languages, Mathematics and Science. Students from all levels will have time set aside to engage in S.T.E.A.M.-related activities like learning coding, attending theatre shows, appreciating performances such as Reader's Theatre and engaging in cultural craft activities.
