P₂ English Assessment Matters

Holistic Assessment



- Teachers share learning intentions and success criteria with students
- Multiple checkpoints throughout the year
- Students are engaged in the assessment process through self/peer checklists and reflections



At the START of P2, students should be able to:

- Listen attentively and follow simple instructions
- Speak clearly to express their thoughts, feelings and ideas
- Follow communication etiquette such as taking turns and using appropriate eye contact and volume in conversations or discussions



At the START of P2, students should be able to:

- Demonstrate basic word recognition skills
- Read aloud simple texts with fluency, accuracy and expression
- Understand simple texts and are able to identify simple aspects of fiction
- Demonstrate writing readiness and handwriting skills
- Write a simple paragraph to recount events




At the END of P2, students should be able to:

- Listen attentively and identify relevant information.
- Speak clearly to express their thoughts, feelings and ideas.
- Build on others' ideas in conversations or discussions respectfully.
- Read multi-syllabic words accurately.
- Read aloud P2 texts with fluency, accuracy and expression.
- Understand P2 texts and are able to identify the big ideas in the texts and recall sequence of main events.
- Apply basic spelling strategies.
- Write a simple paragraph to recount events.
